What have we been up to? Year 4 Update

So far in Year 4 this term we've had lots of fun and been really focussed on our learning! Our Science topic last term was Electricity. We went to Iver Heath Environmental Centre to explore renewable energy sources and different ways of reducing our carbon footprint. We are now exploring solids, liquids and gases through a variety of experiments and investigations.





Our History topic was the Viking and Anglo Saxon struggle for power. We enjoyed finding out all about life in Viking Britain and had a visitor from the British Museum to show us artefacts and tell us more about Viking history.

We've really enjoyed creating sculptures in art this term. We started off using recyclable materials to create an Iron Man (our class book) and then moved on to using our new skills and ModRoc to sculpt the space creature that the Iron Man fought.





For Literacy week we were celebrating the 100th anniversary of Roald Dahl. We focussed on George's Marvellous Medicine and took part in lots of activities related to the book, including writing diaries, designing medicine bottles, creating adverts and even making our own medicine recipe!

We would like to say a big thank you to all the families that came to see our wonderful work from Literacy week. We thoroughly enjoyed creating and designing our marvellous medicine bottles so we were happy you got to see them!



We have been using many different Maths skills so far this term! This fortnight we have been focussing on measures and time and applying our skills to measure and calculate the area of various parts of the school. We've also been reading digital and analogue time and using our knowledge to solve time problems.





Our Geography topic is all about leisure in our local area. We had great fun exploring the school grounds to find our local facilities. We've been improving our map skills by using our findings to create a map of the local area. This links with our ICT topic where we are developing a guide to Lent Rise and the local area using our computing skills.
