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Some Top Tips to get the Year off to a Great Start!

Starting or even starting back at school can be a little tricky for some children (and parents) but there are some simple ways that you can support your child and the staff to ensure a smooth transition:

- Be enthusiastic about school no matter how hard it is on those cold, soggy mornings, being positive about school and learning will help your child behave the same way
- Communicate with school please let us know about any questions, queries or issues; you can contact the school office to speak your child's teacher
- Be on time missing the beginning of the day, even by a few minutes, means your child starts their day rushed and on a back-footing, it also means they may miss vital information about the lesson
- Name absolutely everything!
- Join our PTA this is a great way to make friends with other parents whilst supporting the school

Help with uniform and other school sundries

If you are on a low income or in receipt of certain benefits you may be able to access support with some of the extra costs that come with school life such as uniform or breakfast and afterschool club. The first step is to see if your child is eligible for free school meals - even if they are in Early Years, Year 1 or 2.
