

SCIENCE VOCABULARY

Animals

- Words related to the senses -sight, see, hearing, smell, nose, touch, feel, etc.
- Words for parts of the human body and other animals, e.g. leg, arm.
- Words and phrases relating to living and non-living things, e.g. alive, living.
- Names of common animals and types of animals.
- Understanding the vocabulary 'carnivore, herbivore, and omnivore'.

Growing Plants

- Words and phrases for making comparisons, eg tallest, taller.
- Words relating to plants -branch, flower, root, stem, seeds, etc.
- Words and phrases relating to living and non-living things, eg alive, living.

Materials

- Names of materials -metal, plastic, wood, paper, glass, clay, rock, fabric, sand. Words used to describe materials, eg hard, rough, smooth, shiny, dull.
- Words and phrases used for making comparisons, eg the same as, different from.

Working Scientifically

- Words relating to experiments, eg fair, test, prediction and results.
- Words and phrases used for making comparisons, reasoning and explanations, eg quicker, slower, longer and shorter.

Seasonal Changes

- Words linked to the seasons.
- Words for different types of weather.
- Words to compare seasonal changes, eg hotter, colder, wetter and drier.
